SENIOR SERVICES

Empowers seniors to maintain their health and nutritional well-being and allows seniors to remain in their homes.

10,587

Hot, nutritious meals served to **184** seniors in a congregate setting

23,463

Nutritious meals were delivered to 210 home-bound seniors. 71

Seniors and/or caregivers received assistance to identify needs, access resources and make informed decisions.



ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Heats homes during the winter season and extends budgets for low income households.

360

Households received assistance with their utility payments.

WEATHERIZATION

Lowers energy bills for low-income people.
