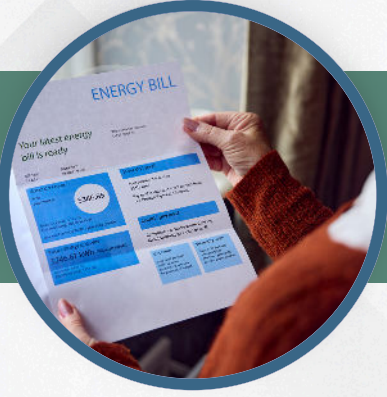
Hot, nutritious meals served to **153** seniors in a congregate setting

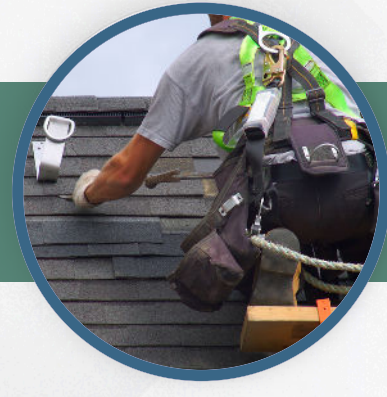
Households had their homes weatherized.

OUTREACH AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

Supports people through a crisis and allows them to utilize their limited income until they reach stability.

Households received crisis financial assistance for transportation, utilities or medical needs impacting **113** individuals.

Households accessed food by visiting the Houston County Food Shelf, impacting **731** individuals.

724

Households were provided information and referrals.

52

Households were assisted with rent or mortgage payments or motel vouchers to prevent homelessness, impacting **170** individuals.

28

Households were provided with holiday/Christmas presents during the holiday season impacting **77** individuals.
