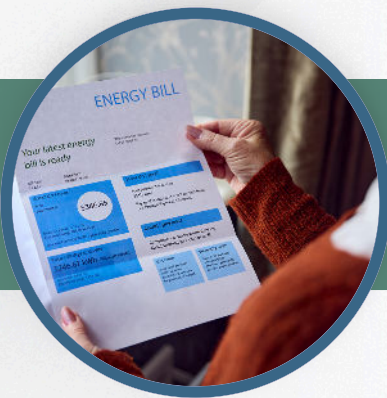
Hot, nutritious meals were served to **713** seniors in a congregate setting.
