

## Semcac Board of Directors Election

### Freeborn County Consumer Board Member

Semcac is a private, nonprofit Community Action Agency that provides programs and services to households in SE MN and Freeborn County. The programs Semcac provides in Freeborn County include Senior Dining, Meals on Wheels/Home Delivered Meals, Energy Assistance, Weatherization, and home improvement loans.

There is an opening on the Semcac Board of Directors for a Consumer representative from Freeborn County. There are 21 members on the Semcac Board of Directors representing seven counties. In order to qualify, potential candidates must live in Freeborn County, and qualify as income eligible (see chart below):

- 2) Complete the application/income verification forms,
- 3) Submit the completed application/income verification via email to [barb.thompson@semcac.org](mailto:barb.thompson@semcac.org) or via postal mail, postmarked by March 31, 2020.

Interested candidates will be placed on a ballot, with election forms provided March 31, 2020 – April 6, 2020.
